### Description of the area covered by the agreement

Clause 1.1 defines ILUA Area as the area described in writing in Schedule 1 and shown on the maps in Schedule 1.

Schedule 1 describes the ILUA Area as that part of Lot 95 on SP265806 within a line joining points 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 12 and 13 as shown on Sheet 2 of 2 at Schedule 1.

[A map of the ILUA area is also contained in Schedule 1. A copy of Schedule 1 is attached to this register extract.

The following general description of the agreement area has been provided by the National Native Title Tribunal to assist people to understand the location of the agreement area. It is provided for information only and should not be considered part of the Register of ILUAs:

The agreement covers about 5 ha, being part of Lot 95 on Plan SP265806, in the vicinity of the intersection of Commercial and Engineering Roads, Mount Isa.]

'ILUA Activities' means all Future Acts by, for, or on behalf of either a Third Party or Local Government which are either necessary for or incidental to excising an area of about 5.037 ha from Lot 73 on SP134707; including that excised area into Lot 95 on SP1347070 which is a reserve for cemetery purposes for which Local Government was gazetted as trustee on 29 February 1964; and the gazettal and use of the ILUA Area as a cemetery.
