Description of the area covered by the agreement

The agreement area covers all the land and waters within Lot 656 on SP138788 (Lanark Pastoral Holding) which fall within the external boundary of native title determination application QUD6230/98 Jangga People (QC98/10) as accepted for registration on 19 October 2004.
