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### 2. TERM

This Agreement commences on the date the last Party executes this Agreement and will continue in perpetuity.

### 4. FUTURE ACTS

(a) The Parties consent to the doing of the Agreed Actions, whether or not the Agreed Actions are Future Acts.

### 5. RIGHT TO NEGOTIATE

Subdivision P (Right to Negotiate), Part 2 of Division 3 of the NTA is not intended to apply to any Future Act described in clause 4.

### 3. ACQUISITION AND GRANT

(a) The Parties acknowledge that upon registration of this ILUA, the Territory agrees, within a reasonable period after the gazettal of the Notice of Acquisition, to effect the grant of an easement for right of way over Perpetual Pastoral Lease 989 to provide reasonable access to the Land (as depicted on Survey Plan S2003/20).

(b) Subject to clause 3(a), the Minister for Lands, Planning and the Environment will publish a Notice of Acquisition in respect of the Land in accordance with section 46(1A) of the *Lands Acquisition Act* (NT) within thirty (30) days of the registration of this Agreement, which will have the effect of:

- (i) acquiring the Land; and
- (ii) granting an estate in fee simple in the Land to the Irrulangwele Aboriginal Corporation (the **Agreed Actions**).
