Description of the area covered by the agreement

Schedule 2 of the agreement describes the agreement area as that part of the Congress Land over which native title was determined to exist in the Approved Determination which is also part of the area of the Lease, as set out in the attached plan SP241617 of Lease ID in Lot 35 on plan SP232620.
