

Fossil Downs Station and Bunuba ILUA

Description

The agreement area covers all the land and waters subject to -

That portion of Fossil Downs Pastoral Lease (N050221) that falls within Native Title Determination WAD94/2012 Bunuba People #2 Part A (WCD2015/009), further described as:

That part of Fossil Downs Pastoral Lease (N050221) that falls west of a line joining a point on the northern boundary Native Title Determination WAD6133/1998 Bunuba (WC1999/019) at Longitude 126.097620° East (Latitude 17.673389° South) and extending north westerly to the centreline of the Fitzroy River at Latitude 17.658670° South (Longitude 126.086860° East).
