SCHEDULE 9 - HIGH NATIVE TITLE IMPACT ACTIVITIES

This Schedule contains classes of *Activities* which have a *High Native Title Impact* (refer to sub-clause 37.3).

Short Description	Class of Activities
High Impact Infrastructure	Anything which consists of the construction or establishment of infrastructure, structures, improvements and earthworks which is not <i>Low Impact Infrastructure</i> .
High Impact Tenure Grant	Means the granting, issuing or making of a lease other than a <i>Permitted Lease</i> or the issue of a deed of grant in fee simple.
Preventing the Exercise of <i>Native Title</i>	Anything which prevents the exercise and enjoyment of Native Title unless the Activity is:
	(a) temporary;
	(b) undertaken for reasons of public health or public safety;
	(c) done pursuant to a Permitted Lease; or
	(d) required by Law.
	Example - Enclosing an area by a fence or other structure which prevents the Native Title Claim Group from entering the area.
High Impact Works/infrastructure Otherwise Agreed at a Capital Works Forum	Anything which involves the construction or establishment of infrastructure, structures, improvements or earthworks and which is decided to be high impact for purposes of <i>Native Title</i> at a <i>Capital Works Forum</i> .
