<sup>&</sup>quot;Applicable Law" means every law and regulation (whether of the Commonwealth or of the State) from time to time in operation in the State which is applicable to a party including any such laws relating to native title, mining, the environment, or Aboriginal heritage;

<sup>&</sup>quot;Licence" means a Speculative Survey Licence granted pursuant to the Petroleum Act;

<sup>&</sup>quot;Petroleum Act" means the Petroleum and Geothermal Energy Act 2000 (SA).
