The agreement area is a 100m wide and approximately 15 km long corridor covering 1.5 sq km and is located approximately 22 km south west of Alice Springs.]

- 2.1 This ILUA commences on the Commencement Date and the obligations, rights, warranties and provisions contained in this ILUA are effective from the Commencement Date.
- 2.5 This ILUA operates for the duration of the Project.

'Commencement Date' means the date of this ILUA, being the date that the last Party executes this ILUA [25 September 2013].

Statements of the kind mentioned in ss. 24EB(1) or 24EBA(1) or (4)

- 4.1 To the extent that any of the Relevant Acts constitute or amount to a Future Act, the Parties consent to the doing of any or all of those Relevant Acts (without conditions) subject to the provisions of this ILUA and agrees not to challenge the validity of the Relevant Acts at any time in the future.
- 4.2 The right to negotiate provisions of Subdivision P of Division 3 of Part 2 of the NTA are not intended to apply to the doing of any or all of the Relevant Acts, and the Parties intend for this ILUA to be for the carrying out of the Project.
- 4.4 The Parties acknowledge and agree that while this ILUA is registered on the Register all Relevant Acts that may have been done invalidly, are to the extent that it is necessary to so provide, valid to the extent that they affect Native Title in the ILUA Area in accordance with section 24EBA(1)(a)(i) of the NTA.

"Powerline" means the proposed high voltage electricity distribution line and associated assets used to transport electricity from Alice Springs to Hermannsburg via Wallace Rockhole.

"Project" means all the operations proposed or which may be undertaken in relation to or incidental to the activities conducted or authorised under any Relevant Acts to develop, construct, install, use, operate, maintain, repair, replace and further develop the Powerline in the ILUA Area.
