PART 1 – AGREEMENT AREA

1. **Description**

External boundary description

The agreement area covers all the land and waters within the external boundary described as:

- (a) ID Area 1A and 1B (Saltwater Inlet) - Lot 1 in DP 620697
- (b) ID Area 2 and 4 – Part of Dalhousie Creek within that area defined as commencing at the north western corner of Lot 7066 in DP 1107446, then southerly along western boundary of that lot to its south western corner, then northerly to the south eastern corner of Lot 1 in DP 620967, then northerly along eastern boundary of that lot to its north eastern corner, then easterly to again the north western corner of Lot 7066 in DP 1107446.
- (c) ID Area 3 - Lot 7066 in DP 1107446
- (d) ID Area 5A - Lot 1 in DP 1193053
- (e) ID Area 5B - Lot 2 in DP 1193053
- (f) ID Area 5C - Lot 3 in DP 1193053
- (g) ID Area 7 - Northern part - Lot 4 in DP 1193053
- (h) ID Area 7 - Southern part - Lot 7064 in DP 1107434
- (i) ID Area 8 – Lot 4 in DP 219743
- (j) ID Area 9 - Lot 1 in DP 609510
- (k) ID Area 10 - McGraths Creek abutting Lot 1 in DP 609510 and Lot 233 in DP 755552
- (l) ID Area 11 - Lot 233 in DP 755552
- (m) ID Area 12 and 20 - Lot 7012 in DP 1107438
- (n) ID Area 13 - Lot 7035 in DP 1107441 (Oyster Creek)
- (o) ID Area 14 - Lot 7034 in DP 1107441
- (p) ID Area 15 and 16 - Part of Lot 8 in DP 1195331, which is in Bellingen Shire Council Local Government Area

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- (q) ID Area 17 and 18 - Part of Oyster Creek which is in the Bellingen Shire Council Local Government Area and south of Lot 7012 in DP 1107438

2. Surrender Area

- (a) ID Area 5A East - The eastern part of Lot 1 in DP 1193053, being that part subject to former Lot 7065 in DP 1107444
