External boundary description

The agreement area covers all the land and waters within an area 50 metres either side of a line commencing at Easting 371774.22, Northing 7365862.47 and defined by bearings and distances displayed on the map contained in Schedule 2.

The agreement area specifically excludes any land within NT Portions 6663, 6221 and 4130.
