## **Schedule 2** Low Native Title Impact Activities

(clause 1.1 and clause 13.5)

- 1. The low native title impact activities are any or all of the following:
  - (a) inspecting, maintaining, repairing and reinstating electricity infrastructure or access tracks;
  - (b) tree lopping and tree clearing:
    - (i) in the immediate vicinity of electricity infrastructure;
    - (ii) required for the safe operation or use of the electricity infrastructure; or
    - (iii) required for public health or safety;
  - (c) installing street light poles and service/intermediate poles that are tied into the existing powerline system in urban areas/town precincts;
  - (d) the performance of statutory duties and responsibilities under the Electricity Act, Electricity Regulation or other laws;
  - (e) the grant of any valid lease, easement, permit, licence or other interest to Ergon Energy which was operative prior to the execution date from the owner or occupier of land for a use of or incidental to the performance of statutory duties and responsibilities under the Electricity Act, Electricity Regulation or other laws;
  - (f) the exercise by Ergon Energy of any rights or obligations under any way-leave agreement, easement, license, permit or other interest over land or waters that are validly operative as at the execution date;
  - (g) accessing the Agreement Area for the purpose of undertaking any low native title impact activity.
- 2. Ergon Energy will comply with the following procedures when conducting low native title impact activities:
  - (a) take reasonable measures to rehabilitate any damage or interference to land or waters caused by the *low native title impact activities*;
  - (b) not access any building used as a dwelling or the curtilage of a building used as a dwelling unless *Ergon Energy* has obtained the necessary consents or warrants required by law to access the building or the curtilage; and
  - (c) perform the activities in accordance with the standards of skill and safety required under the Electricity Act and Electricity Regulation.
