(a) This Agreement commences on the date the last Party executes this Agreement and will continue in perpetuity.

- 3 Future Acts
- 3.1 Surrender and Extinguishment
- (a) The Parties consent to the surrender of any native title rights and interests in the Land held by the Warai and Kungarakany Groups, whether or not this surrender is a Future Act.
- (b) The Parties agree that the surrender of native title under this Agreement is intended to extinguish all native title rights and interests in the Land held by the Warai and Kungarakany Groups.
- 3.2 Validation of Prior Acts
- (a) The Parties agree to the validation of all Prior Acts (if any) done invalidly by the Territory.
- 3.3 Right to Negotiate
- (a) Subdivision P (Right to Negotiate), Part 2 of Division 3 of the NTA is not intended to apply to any Future Act described in this clause 3.
