Description

The agreement area covers all the land and waters subject to -

That portion of Jubilee Downs Pastoral Lease (N050571) that falls within Native Title Determination WAD6133/1998 Bunuba (WCD2012/006) and Native Title Determination WAD94/2012 Bunuba People #2 Part A (WCD2015/009), further described as:

That part of Jubilee Downs Pastoral Lease (N050571) north east of a line passing through the following coordinate points:

LONGITUDE (EAST)	LATITUDE (SOUTH)
125.360740	18.094577
125.495200	18.195500

Then extending south easterly to the intersection with a western boundary of the western severance of Reserve 40940 at Latitude 18.229363 South.

Reference datum
